### **What is Art After Dark?**

AAD is a late-night program for Miami students where they can choose from a variety of different art and craft activities. We've been doing this program for years. Hundreds of students participate in the event each semester.

### **What do you need stuff for?**

### **How can Kramer parents help?**

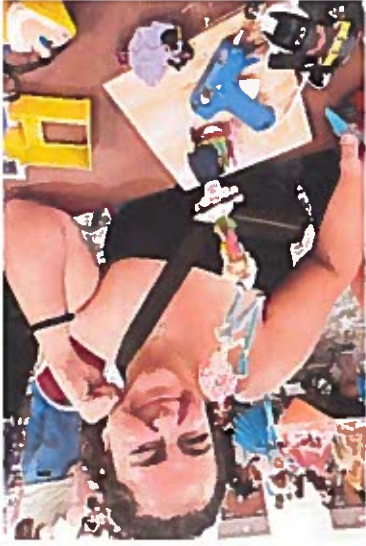
