### Student Cell Phone Usage

As you probably heard, the state of Ohio has required that cell phones be off and away in all classrooms. Our code of conduct at THS already reflects this protocol.

Here are the steps that will be followed should a student have their phone on/out during classes:

- 1st incident the teacher will ask for the phone it will be held/stored until the end of class
- 2<sup>nd</sup> incident the teacher will ask for the phone and it will held/stored in the office until the end of the school day
- 3<sup>rd</sup> incident the teacher will ask for the phone and it will be held/stored in the office until a parent/guardian can pick it up Subsequent incidents handled on a case-by-case basis by administration

Please note, students refusing to comply with an adult's request to turn their phone in are subject to additional consequences

#### **Drop-off & Pick-up Information:**

The map below provides the traffic pattern for student drop-off/pick-up and student parking each morning/afternoon. For those needing to drop off before 7:55 am, the Main Entrance doors will open at 7:00 am. Any student entering before 7:55 am will report directly to the cafeteria. For those dropping off, please pull forward as far along the path laid out by the red arrows as possible before stopping. Students can use the cafeteria, event, and main entrances as of 7:55 am. Please be mindful, students will be crossing from the parking lot during this time. Crosswalks will be available, but it is important to proceed slowly and cautiously during drop-off and pick-up. There will be an 8:11 am warning bell before the 8:15 am start of first period.
